

David Malahoff has co-produced previous PEI productions of *Anne & Gilbert* (2005-2009). He was the co-producer of *The New, New Potato Time Review* featuring Patrick Ledwell and Tanya Davis. Previously, he was Executive Producer of CBC Radio's top rated *Basic Black*. At CBC Radio, he created the popular *Hum Line* musical quiz show featuring Arthur Black, Shelagh Rogers and Danny Marks. He also created and produced the music programs *Under the Covers and Duets*. Moving to CBC Newsworld, he was Senior Producer for CBC Newsworld's *Big Life*. Malahoff was the creator and writer of the documentary *Scars* on CBC-TV.



Campbell Webster has produced or licensed all productions of *Anne & Gilbert* since it first hit the stage at The Victoria Playhouse. In 1988, he founded Campbell Webster Entertainment which managed various artists including Lennie Gallant, Nancy White, and John Southworth. As a Founding Director of the East Coast Music Association, an event he chaired for two years, he created many of its signature events including the 72- *Hour Jam* and Radio ECMA. His television production career included two Gemini nominations, and credits as a Producer on the lifestyle series *My Messy Bedroom* and the animated CBC series *And Yet I Blame Hollywood*. His management company also runs the CW Foundation, a charitable foundation devoted to social justice in Atlantic Canada and Latin America. His more than a decade of writing columns for the PEI daily, The Guardian, resulted in a compilation of those columns, entitled *And Another Thing*.



Joe Byrne is ecstatic to return as producer on a show that he has enjoyed for more than a decade and a half. When he is not doing production tasks on Anne and Gilbert he is involved in his other passions of social justice and community development. He works on his communications skills through teaching driving to young people and newcomers to PEI.

The Wardrobe and Props Department of Anne and Gilbert, the Musical have started a reduce, recycle, and reuse policy for the materials leftover in their departments. Small remnants of materials: fabrics, stuffing, thread, ribbon, buttons, leftover from building the costumes and props have, in the past ended up in the landfills. Now these odds and ends are no longer tossed but are preserved to created special souvenirs for you, lovingly hand-made in

PEI, by members of the A&G Wardrobe and Props departments. Each item is made from remnants of the costumes and props used in this production and productions as far back as the show's first opening. The bows (made by Hailee White) are fashioned after those worn by the actors in this production.

The souvenir patchwork bears (made by Sarah Bruce) are replicates of the youngest schoolgirl's bear. Each bear is built from small costume remnants. Thread and material too small to be used is collected and is stuffed into each bear, leaving nothing to waste.

The department members are proud of their initiative in helping to preserve the environment and are very pleased to offer you these special mementos.
